The Evening Program strongly believes that the social/personal interaction of staff and students is an intricate opponent of the learning process. As such, fully understanding the need to adhere to safety and best preventive practice, we will adhere to the following structure:

Students will enter the building using door 25. All classes will be held in room 188

Class begins at 6:00pm and students should arrive on time but no later than 5:55 Pm

In-person learning is the mode of instruction and attendance allowing for participation and exchange is the means of success. Students will be given access to Google classroom only if they are in attendance. Evening school will provide you an opportunity to either: graduate on time in the day or earn your diploma at night. As such, being here and doing your work is imperative.

If you have transferred from the Day division to the Evening before your original year of Graduation, You must enroll fulltime and are required to pass each class in which you are enrolled.

If you can not commit to being physically in attendance then you should rethink your decision to enroll in the evening program.

Attendance regulations are as follows: 1st and 2nd absent is excused with legitimate reason submitted.

Absenteeism greater than 3 times is subject to review with class removal a possible consequence.
